## 1) State legislation

- Garin is watching several bills regarding education, human trafficking and regulating professions none of which appear to have a direct impact on massage therapists at this time
- Senate Bill 19-089 Exempt Colorado Department of Higher Education Regulation Professional Organization Member Education <a href="https://leg.colorado.gov/bills/sb19-089">https://leg.colorado.gov/bills/sb19-089</a>
  - Stakeholder Meeting January 31, 2019
    - Garin, David, Tsy, Sarah and Laura were in attendance; representatives from the physical therapists, public accountants, acupuncturists, landscape architects as well as DPOS and Department of Higher Education
    - Most appreciated the intent of the bill but felt that the bill language was too broad
    - DPOS expressed concern that proposed language will supplant NCBTMB and other organizations over their role and that there was not enough consumer protection or financial stability required
    - DPOS is open to further discussions
  - Senate Bill 19-089 heard in Senate <u>State</u>, <u>Veterans</u>, <u>& Military Affairs</u> Committee February 4, 2019
     committee vote was to postpone bill indefinitely
    - Alfred expressed appreciation for those who were in attendance to support/testify on behalf of the bill
    - Committee response included change to DPOS rules and policy rather than change in statute
  - Discussion from Tami, Chris, Garin and others support continuing communication with DPOS to bring about resolution
