- Colorado session has ended.
- Two updates not related to specific legislation:
 - Senate Minority Leader Paul Lundeen is resigning immediately to work for a non-profit. Republicans are meeting tomorrow to choose a new minority leader.
- June 18 is the Senate Budget forecast. Budget is very tight and affected by Federal cuts which will likely impact Medicaid funding.

3. National legislation

- Oklahoma passed a bill to extend the cosmetology & barber license board but the governor vetoed the bill due to reasons of inefficiency. AMTA lobbyist secured an extension of the bill until 2026. We are trying to move massage under healthcare rather than be overseen by the cosmetology and barber board.
- No further updates on the Interstate compact for the rest of this year.
